

Steilacoom Civil Service Commission Minutes
March 4, 2021

<u>Call to Order:</u>	Vice-chair Maus called the March 4, 2021 regular meeting of the Steilacoom Civil Service Commission to order at 2:00 p.m. via Zoom.
<u>Roll Call:</u>	In attendance were Chair Jacobs, Vice-chair Maus, and Commissioner Lynch. Staff members present were the Town Administrator, Paul Loveless, Chief Yabe, Sergeant Bailey, Detective Hamrick, and Secretary Sterbick.
<u>Approval of Minutes:</u> February 4, 2021 Yes: All	Vice-chair Maus moved to approve and Commissioner Lynch seconded approval the February 4, 2021 minutes as written.
<u>Rule 6.20</u> <u>Virtual Oral Boards</u> Yes: All	<p>Secretary Sterbick explained the Town was seeking a change to rule 6.20 that would allow virtual oral boards. She indicated this would be useful in circumstances where out-of-state applicants are unable to attend an oral board, or when, as with the current pandemic, meeting in-person could jeopardize the health of participants.</p> <p>Attention was drawn to the proposed rule change language noting it would be at the Commission's discretion to approve an in-person and/or virtual oral board process.</p> <p>Vice-chair Maus moved to accept the proposed changes to rule 6.20 allowing the Commission to approve virtual oral boards. Commissioner Lynch seconded approval.</p>
<u>Reports</u>	<p>Paul Loveless reported Mayor Lucas resigned his position effective March 2, 2021.</p> <p>He stated Council has 90 days to decide on a process to fill the position and to make an appointment. He informed the Commissioners that Council was slated to meet on March 16, 2021 to decide the process. In the interim, Mr. Loveless identified Fred Crumley as Mayor Pro-tem. He reported this was an election this year for the position (4-year term).</p> <p>Chief Yabe introduced Justin Hamrick as the new Detective.</p>
