<p><b><u>Call to Order:</u></b></p>	<p>Chair Jacobs called the March 7, 2019 regular meeting of the Steilacoom Civil Service Commission to order at 2:00 p.m. in the Steilacoom Community Center conference room.</p>
<p><b><u>Roll Call:</u></b></p>	<p>In attendance were Chair Jacobs, and Vice-chair Maus. Staff members representing the Town were Chief Rodriguez, Detective Bailey, the Town Administrator, Paul Loveless, and Secretary Sterbick. Commissioner Lynch was absent.</p>
<p><b><u>Approval of Minutes:</u></b> <b>February 7, 2019</b></p> <p><b>Yes: All</b></p>	<p>Vice-chair Maus moved and Chair Jacobs seconded to approve the minutes of the February 7, 2019 meeting as written.</p>
<p><b><u>Discussion / Action</u></b> <b>Register Certification</b></p> <p><b>Yes: All</b></p> <p><b>Disqualifications</b></p> <p><b>Yes: All</b></p>	<p>Secretary Sterbick presented an open competitive register for certification (dated 3/7/19). The register was comprised of remaining names from the November 1, 2018 register and additional names to be added from applicants passing the oral board on February 28, 2019.</p> <p>Vice-chair Maus moved to approve the 3/7/19 OC register as presented. Chair Jacobs seconded approval.</p> <p>A list of applicant names for disqualification was presented to the Commission. Secretary Sterbick asked that Commissioners approve the names for disqualification.</p> <p>Detective Bailey reviewed individual names/reasons for disqualification with the Commission.</p> <p>Vice-chair Maus moved to remove Blowers, Dreyer, Gibbs, Harris, Murphy, and Wright from the application process. Chair Jacobs seconded approval.</p>
<p><b><u>Reports:</u></b></p>	<p>Chair Jacobs inquired as to where we were in reviewing disqualifiers for possible rule revisions.</p> <p>Secretary Sterbick explained that consensus was that all commissioners wished to be present for any discussions regarding rule revisions and the next meeting at which all could be present would be the May 2, 2019 meeting.</p> <p>Secretary Sterbick expressed concern that at the May 2, 2019 meeting, Commissioners would be hearing two appeals and may not have time for review of the rules.</p> <p>Town Administrator, Paul Loveless, suggested having rule review on the agenda and moving review if the agenda proved to be too full.</p>
