

Steilacoom Civil Service Commission Minutes
February 6, 2020

<u>Call to Order:</u>	Chair Jacobs called the February 6, 2020 meeting of the Steilacoom Civil Service Commission to order at 2:02 p.m. in the Steilacoom Community Center conference room.
<u>Roll Call:</u>	In attendance were Chair Jacobs, Vice-chair Maus, and Commissioner Lynch. Staff members present were Town Administrator, Paul Loveless, Acting Chief Yabe, and Secretary Sterbick.
<u>Approval of Minutes:</u> January 2, 2020 Yes: All	Vice-chair Maus moved and Commissioner Lynch seconded to approve the minutes of the January 2, 2020 meeting as written.
<u>Discussion/Action:</u> <u>Drug Use Disqualifiers</u> 6.10.090	<p>Secretary Sterbick presented updated, proposed changes to the drug use disqualifiers. Proposed changes incorporated changes discussed/requested during the January 2, 2020 meeting.</p> <p>Secretary Sterbick explained the first change to the disqualifiers (as listed on PST) was to specifically address CBD products. In addition, the Commissioners had requested adding 'prior to application' after 'no illegal use last five years' under amphetamines, steroids, and club drugs.</p> <p>Secretary Sterbick addressed the deletion of <i>'illegal use of a controlled substance after submitting an application to any law enforcement agency'</i>. She indicated 'applicant has obtained a prescription for a controlled substance under false pretenses' had been designated as an automatic disqualifier while 'any illegal/unauthorized use of prescription medication' had been designated as a potential disqualifier.</p> <p>Chair Jacobs called for a motion. Vice-chair Maus moved to approve the agency disqualifiers as presented. Commissioner Lynch seconded pending discussion.</p> <p>Commissioner Lynch questioned 'no use' as this would include legally prescribed drugs taken for legitimate reasons. Chair Jacobs questioned whether the intent was to address illegal or illegally obtained drugs.</p> <p>Commissioner Lynch expressed concern over the abuse of legally prescribed drugs.</p> <p>Commissioners continued discussions on the proposed language. The final determination was to add the word 'illegal' after 'no' under the categories amphetamines and steroids. All other language was to remain as presented.</p> <p>Chair Jacobs called a vote.</p>
